This session provides an overview of Type K Shrinkage-Compensating Concrete and its use in common industrial applications like slabs-on-grade, bridge deck designs, parking structures and containment tanks. It covers Type K cement's ability to minimize key challenges in concrete applications, like cracking, curling and drying shrinkage are discussed, as well as the advantages it offers in joint placement design and reduced in-service operations and maintenance costs. Guidelines for designing and specifying Type K are reviewed, as well as specification and installation "best practices" to ensure durable, long-term performance.
